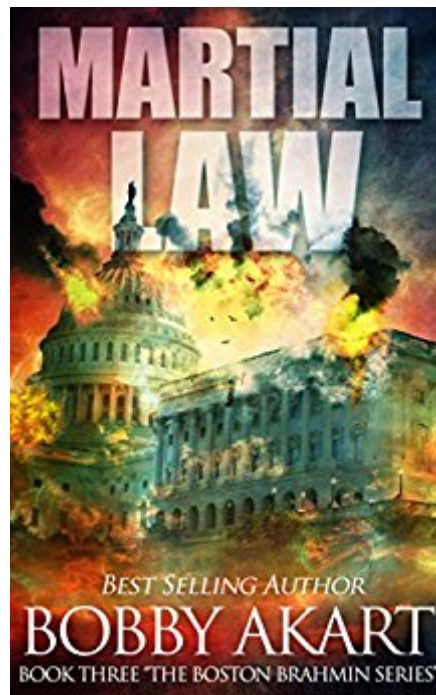


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Martial Law: A Post-Apocalyptic Fiction Series (The Boston Brahmin Book 3)
