The genre, a SHTF, but especially from an EMP, or solar flare is one I have read from numerous authors because of the distinct probability of it happening sometime or another. The author leads you on a very realistic, believable journey of what life will be like when, not if, it happens. I feel the author could make a great series that could go on for awhile in several different books if she wants, and also be successful with them also if she does as well with them as she did with this introduction to the series.
