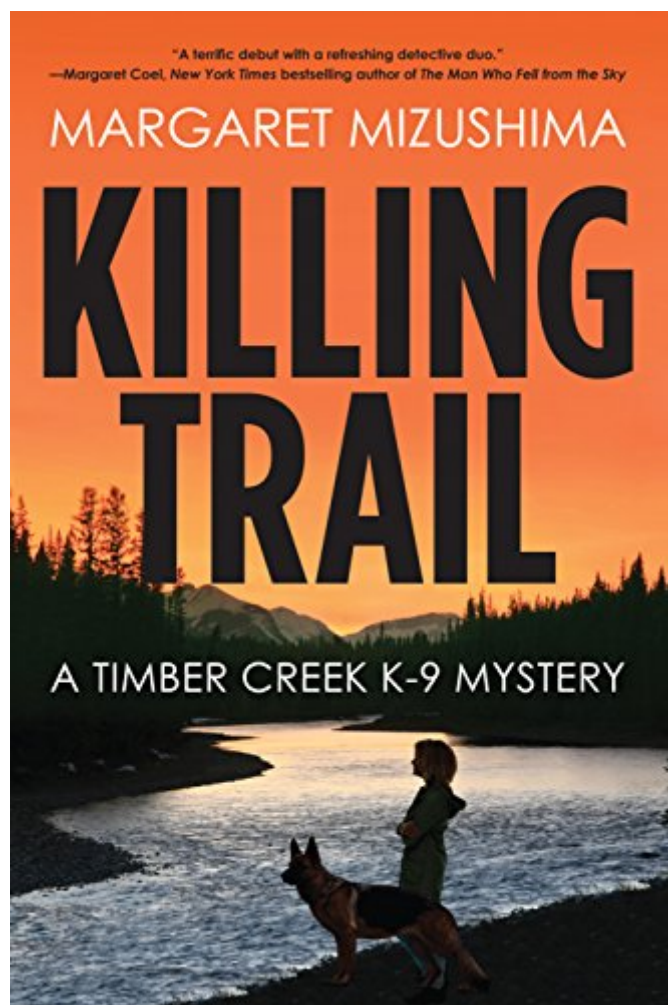

Deputy Mattie Lu Cobb & Timber Creek County's new police service dog, a German shepherd named Robo just became the first K-9 unit ever mobilized in the small town of Timber Creek Colorado. When drug traffic in the national forest had threatened Timber Creek, local merchants

and ranchers had purchased a patrol dog for the sheriff's department. Mattie had won the assignment of being Robo's handler by beating her colleagues in a cross country endurance test. The twelve weeks she'd spent at K-9 Academy were among the best weeks of her life. The novel opens with Mattie receiving a message about a blood spill, out of season. She's to meet Sheriff McCoy ten miles from Ute Canyon turnoff near an old hunting cabin. This would be her first K-9 assignment since the academy, and she couldn't wait to get started. So begins this fine mystery adventure. The novel's setting really adds to the storyline as it is of a small community having to face some big city problems. The characters are drawn accurately and believable. The author takes time with them, leaving room to flush them out fully in further adventures as this debut is surely the beginning of a successful series in the making. The relationship of Mattie and Robo is front and center and superbly drawn by the author. Margaret Mizushima's due diligence to the nature of the K-9 drug culture refreshingly manifests itself throughout her writing/...she needed more training than Robo...she could show her excitement and more. It was part of the job...Mattie used a higher pitched voice, something she'd been taught that would rev up his prey drive and get him ready to search...slurped a few times. Moisture enhanced a dog's sense of smell...
